After receiving several tips called in by concerned citizens, the Gallatin Police Department was able to identify the suspect wanted in connection to the armed robbery of the Tennessee Credit Union. All of the tipsters called in as a result of information broadcast by the news media showing photos of the suspect during the robbery. Investigators were then able to locate the suspect in Nashville resulting in the arrest without incident of Christopher K Chipman, 40 years of age. A weapon and money connecting Chipman to the robbery were recovered. Christopher Chipman, pictured below, is being held in the Sumner County jail on \$52,500 bond at this time. Chipman is charged with Aggravated Robbery and Theft over \$1000.
